News

Summary of incidents in Burbage this month

- Attempt break to van on Lutterworth Road on 7th September 2021. Suspect disturbed and nothing taken.
- Residential burglary on Rugby Road. Residents not present at the time of the incident on 9th September 2021.
- Land Rover Range Rover stolen via keyless entry from the Rainbow Way (Hanson cab) area on 9th September.
- Attempt residential burglary at the locations of Sharpless Road and Craigowan close. Residents have returned home to find damage to doors/handles. Entrance not gained.
- We have received 8 reports relating to a crime spree overnight on the 18th September. Vehicles were damaged around Boyslade Road, Cotes Road and Coventry Road. This incident is currently under investigation.
- Catalytic converter theft from a vehicle on Forresters road on the 24th September.

Good results and activity this month

- Missing dog from the Burbage common area reunited with owner.
- Plenty of crime prevention work completed with residents this month including visits, beat surgery, events and leaflet drops. Also spoke to residents where we have found valuables in vehicles or insecure property.
- Stolen bicycle from Hinckley returned to keeper.
- Lots of car key wallets provided (£2) to Burbage residents to help reduce keyless car crime.
- Targeted patrols based on resident feedback. This has resulted in several stop searches and the recovery of drugs, vehicles and other items. Locations include Featherston Drive and Lutterworth Road.

You said – Road safety

We did – Completed a speed safety event at several locations raised as concerns by Burbage residents. These were Lutterworth Road, Coventry Road and Sapcote Road (2 locations). Tickets were issued and letter sent. Hopefully our presence raises awareness and makes people think twice about speed. The fastest speed monitored was 42Mph in a 30Mph zone. We will continue with these events based on feedback. We have also spoken to several drivers around illegal/dangerous parking particularly in school areas.

You said – Vehicle Crime

We did – We have provided lots of residents with RFID car key wallets (£2 sold at cost) to support with this concern. We have had 1 vehicle stolen this month so overall crime figures are good but it is always worth being mindful around vehicle security. Never leave valuables in your vehicle, especially with the darker nights coming.

You said – Dog Waste

We did – We work with HBBC to try and identify anyone caught leaving dog waste, litter or fly tipping. If you have any information or images that may help us challenge these issues please either contact me or you can report direct to HBBC with the below links.
