INDIVIDUAL MAKING A DIFFERENCE AWARDS 2017		
HELPING HANDS AWARD	An individual volunteer who provides practical or emotional support to a group or individual.	Volunteer living and providing support in Hinckley and Bosworth (H+B).
GOOD NEIGHBOUR AWARD	An individual volunteer who looks out for and provides support to a neighbour or neighbours.	Volunteer living in H+B benefits residents in immediate area.
GROUP CONTRIBUTION	An individual who has played a key role in establishing or sustaining a community group.	Volunteer is a H+B resident and group have a H+B focus.
LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT	Longstanding commitment to a project/s or individual/s in H+B.	Volunteer who has had a sustained and significant impact over a long period of time.
YOUNG VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR	A 16-25 year old volunteer who has made an important contribution during 2016/17.	H+B resident supporting a group or individual in H +B.
PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT AWARD	An individual who has improved their personal skills and life prospects through volunteering.	H+B resident making identifiable personal improvements.

NEIGHBOURHOOD IMPROVEMENT	A group of H+B residents who have improved a H+B neighbourhood.	Social or environmental impact on local area.
HELPING HANDS	A group who provide practical or emotional support to H+B residents	Improvements in quality of life.
BEST NEW PROJECT	A new service or activity provided to H+B residents.	Initiative formalised after Jan 2015 by H+B volunteers.
LONGSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT	A group that has improved the quality of life for residents in H+B for many years.	H+B group with longstanding and consistent service.
