What we did:

- *Targeted patrols around Burbage, visited many areas and spoke to residents about Neighbourhood Link whilst in the area. I also managed to do two Beat surgeries at The Co-op on Boyslade road and the Three Pots Post Office.
- *Held a neighbourhood meeting with residents to discuss crime, what the Police are doing and crime prevention.
- *We put the Mobile Vehicle Activated Sign (MVAS) box on Greenmoor road for two weeks. We have the results so if you would like to see them, please get in touch so I can Email them to you.
- *I visited Burbage Pre-school and spoke to the children about road safety. We had fun with the Burbage Bear and Police uniform. The engagement was enjoyed by all.
- *We have attended reports of suspicious vehicles in the area and dealt with leading to some positive results. Thanks for the calls raising the concerns.
- *Closure order completed on an address in Burbage due to ongoing anti-social behaviour issues. Work completed between Residents, Police and HBBC.
