#### Summary of incidents in Burbage this month

It has been overall a good month for crime figures in Burbage. Here is a summary of incidents for the month.

- One theft of motor vehicle. A Ford S-Max Titanium was stolen from a grass verge on Wolvey road at the start of the month. Believed to be keyless entry.
- 2 incidents of theft of vehicle registration plates from Lysander Close and Sapcote Road
- 1 vehicle window smashed on Duport road. No attempt theft.
- A couple of incidents of Anti-Social behaviour around Hastings High School and Tilton Rod park.
- Continued reports of scams via Email, TXT and phone calls.

Please continue to consider home security and remain vigilant especially if you are planning on spending time away from home. Jewellery and cash are the main target of criminals. Please don't leave anything in your vehicle. Please ensure your report crime immediately to 101 or 999.

### #YouSaidWeDid

#### **You said – Road Safety**

We did – We have completed a speed event and have planned more in. Several locations visited and this involved challenging not only speeding but also dangerous parking. We have worked with local schools and received some great feedback around the work we have done. Competitions, prizes, education and spreading the message of road safety has been a massive focus for the beat team. We will continue to support. We have also challenged issues raised and signposted residents to relevant agencies. #### **You said – Vehicle Crime**

We did – We have continued to patrol Burbage and complete stop checks, seize vehicles and responded to reports of suspicious vehicles. We have supported residents with crime prevention products and advice. We have had one vehicle stolen this month, 2 sets of registration plates and one vehicle window smashed where there was no attempt of theft. We have also continued with leaflet drops to raise awareness of theft of and from vehicles, also supplied keyless car wallets to residents.

#### **You said – Dog fouling (complaints from several areas of Burbage)**

We did – We have been speaking to the Clean Neighbourhood Officer at HBBC to work together to try and address the concerns raised. We have helped with the replacement of a litter bin on Rugby Road that had been previously removed and still have a supply of stickers if you would like one for a lamppost on your travels. It is an individual's responsibility to clean up and keep Burbage a clean place to be for everyone.
