#### Summary of incidents in Burbage this month

We have continued to address reports of Anti-social behaviour this month. Complaints include reports of Cannabis use from residential addresses as well as at parks. Targeted Patrols continue and anyone found to be involved will, and has been dealt with as appropriate. We work with the local council and other partner agencies to address all types of Anti-social behaviour. We ask that you provide us with as much information as possible to help challenge this type of behaviour.

We have had one vehicle stolen (keyless) and 2 van breaks this month. This follows several months of reduced activity. Please continue to be aware of vehicle crime and implement simple security measures to help prevent becoming the next victim. Continue to remove valuables from your car/van. Never leave anything on show. Do not leave loose change, tools or mobile phones in your vehicle. Remember car key wallets if your vehicle is keyless.

Neighbourhood watch have launched a Burglaries prevention promotion so be sure to have a look. **[Ourwatch.org.uk](http://Ourwatch.org.uk)** Remember that a lot of our burglaries happen when residents are not in. If you plan on going away on holiday PLEASE complete a home security check before you go. Always remove jewellery and cash from your property as these are the items that generally get targeted. Consider window alarms, outdoor lights, light timers and house alarms. Some of these items can be cheap but affective.

We attended Coventry Road, Forrester's Road, Twycross road, Boyslade Road and Church Street with community speed watch to monitor speeding at these locations.

Extra officers have been patrolling the area over the weekends and are continuing to do so to monitor local activity. If you use Facebook you may see updates and photos on this. Things appear to have gone well in Burbage with few reported incidents and good feedback from the local community.

We have been visiting local residents and engaging around complaints of anti-social behaviour. This has included warning letters, home visits and targeted patrols at highlighted areas.
