Summary of incidents in Burbage this month

It has been a good month overall for crime figures in Burbage. Here is a summary of incidents for the month.

- Catalytic converter theft from Lychgate Lane.
- Continuation at the start of January of egg throwing. Nothing since though.
- 2 bicycles stolen from a shed on Oak Close.
- 1 set of number plates taken from a vehicle on Applebee Road.
- Theft of van from Salisbury Road.
- Smashed glass on a green house on Woodbank.

Online scams have also been raised as a community concern. These are generally through Email, TXT message or phone calls. Thankfully it does not appear we have had too many victims but please continue to stay vigilant. These scams can be very convincing and with the increase of online use and shopping, there is more potential for criminals to catch you out.

What we did:

1. Spoke to residents and addressed some of the concerns raised around parking and speeding. We are currently working with the Parish around the MVAS box to capture speeds. We are also working with local schools to move forward with complaints and find solutions
2. Visited individuals who have had incidents around fraud. Also completed targeted leaflet drops with advice. Also raise awareness through neighbourhood link with scams affecting local residents. If you know of someone or an area that could do with a bit of support then get in touch.
3. Completing targeted patrols including stop searches in areas raised as concerns by residents. Also completing with residents to try and resolve neighbour disputes. Areas include Lutterworth Road, East Close, all Local Parks, Aston Lane and many more. We attempt to patrol these areas in line with your feedback.
