Summary of incidents in Burbage this month

Towards the end of June, we have suffered several incidents of vehicle crime. These incidents were generally overnight and from vehicles parked on the road.

Vehicle crime incidents include theft from vehicle. Items taken include cash, bags and passports. Two people were arrested and investigations continue following the recent increase but please be reminded not to leave anything in your vehicle.

There were also a couple of theft from Vans where some tools were taken and a theft from shed where a bicycle and tools were taken.

Areas affected include Britannia Road, Church Street, Coventry Road, Bullfurlong Lane, Sketchley Road, Lychgate Lane and Amber Way. As you may see, most of these locations are towards the top end of Burbage but it is well worth everyone remaining mindful around home/vehicle security.

We have also been working on reports of Anti-social behaviour, speeding complaints, neighbour disputes, drug use and other road safety concerns.

Patrols have included all local parks, areas that have been targeted for crime and locations raised as concerns by residents that may have criminal activity in the area. Remember to get in touch if you have any times/days and locations that you suspect criminal activity is happening so we can deal with this.

You said – Anti-Social Behaviour

We did – We have identified many of those involved in recent ASB. This has been achieved by working with local residents and Schools to identify those involved. We then contact parents, complete home visits and issue the most relevant outcome. This can include words of advice, Warning letters, behaviour contracts, support from youth offending or Leicestershire family's, community resolutions (paying for damage, litter picking), these are some of the options available to us depending on the level of crime, history, parent support and evidence. Patrols continue around the area and we continue to work with local schools.

You said – Road Safety

We did – We completed a speed event in the village this month. As a result, 3 tickets were issued as well as many warning letters. We visited locations raised as concerns by residents. These locations were Sketchley Road, Brookside, Forresters Road and Lutterworth Road. Speeds caught include a 48Mph in a 30Mph.

We will continue with these events to do what we can to keep raising awareness and challenging all types of road safety concerns such as speeding, cycle safety, dangerous parking and driving standards.

You said – Vehicle Crime

We did – The majority of vehicle crime has involved theft from vehicles following a Spate of crime over the recent weeks. Two arrests were made and investigations are ongoing. We are collecting CCTV and supporting investigating officers with enquiries. Whilst we are completing targeted patrols, we would ask that you please ensure you do not leave anything in your vehicle. This includes empty bags, money or phones/laptops. Please also ensure your sheds are locked up and please try to remove tools from your van. We are also completing stop searches of persons and vehicles in the area.
