Summary of incidents in Burbage this month

Again it has been a very good month in relation to crime figures around residential burglary and vehicle theft. The only concerns we have had relate to a theft of a Ford Focus Turbo from Sketchley grange Hotel area. We do see phases of certain types of vehicle being targeted. These have included high powered VW Golf, Ford Focus ST Turbo 2/3 and Fiat 500 Abarth. Throughout the month we have continued to speak to residents around vehicle security. Please continue to be vigilant and consider security such as steering locks, CCTV and house alarms.

We have also seen some damage to the play area on Tilton Road Park. We continue to work with local residents to try and identify those involved. Please remember to report anti-social behaviour including people on mopeds in parks. If enough information is provided, we can issue the owners with a S59 to remove the vehicle. We are passionate about trying to keep these areas safe and useable for our young residents to play in. Report Anti-social behaviour via link,

What we did:

We managed to remove a vehicle from Salem Road and contacted a registered keeper of another. We have been working with HBBC to try and remove other vehicles reported to us. We also try to locate the keeper of the vehicle to resolve promptly but this is not always possible.

We work with residents to resolve issues. Sometimes addressing issues at an early stage can stop escalation if both parties can be brought together. Times are difficult for everyone at the moment and we all have our own circumstances. Please look out and support each other through these trying times.

Support is also needed for our younger residents. Social media is being relied upon for people of all ages. This has its benefits but also has disadvantages.
